## **ECHO Questions and Answers**

# **20 Minute Conversation "Community Action Minnesota"**

**Preface:** For more than 45 years Community Action agencies have been fighting poverty. Their goal is to help people lift themselves out of poverty.

#### 1. What is a Community Action Agency?

#### Sample Answer:

- It is a community-based organization with programs started in 1964 to fight poverty
- These agencies exist all over the United States
- In Minnesota we have 28 agencies serving all the counties and they are on all tribal nations in our state
- Free services are offered to everyone who needs them from infants to elders
- Low income community members serve on Community Action Boards to provide guidance on what is most important to help people help themselves.

#### 2. How do you fight poverty?

- Our strategy is to help people to help themselves
- Our motto is: "Helping People, Changing Lives."
- We provide many services and training programs
- If a particular agency doesn't offer a service, we refer you to someone who does

#### 3. Can you list the services you offer that help fight poverty?

#### Sample Answer:

- Yes, but each agency offers a different combination of services
  - o If they don't have a service, they can refer you to another place that offers the service
- Here are some of our more common services:
  - Head Start
  - o Energy Assistance
  - Weatherization
  - o Housing assistance
  - o Food support
  - Senior services
  - o Financial fitness training
  - o Tax preparation
  - o Job support such as transportation, child care etc.

#### 4. Let's talk about your various services. Please explain Head Start.

#### Sample answer:

- Head Start is for preschool children ages 3 to 5 and their families
- Early Head Start serves newborn babies to 3-year-olds and pregnant mothers
- Head Start is a program designed to get these children ready to learn in school
- Head Start provides a variety of services:
  - o Education
  - o Health
  - o Nutrition
  - Parent involvement and family support Do you have a program for even younger children?

#### 5. Why should children start education program before kindergarten?

- Children will be more successful in school if they start early
- Healthy children have a better chance to be successful
- Learning begins the moment you are born

#### 6. What is energy assistance?

Sample answer:

- Energy Assistance is help paying for heating costs
- The costs to heat your home get very high in winter in Minnesota
- Some agencies can help with energy-related repairs
  - o For example furnace repair

#### 7. What is weatherization?

Sample answer:

- Our weatherization programs reduce energy costs and make homes more energy efficient warmer in the winter, cooler in the summer
  - o Education know where heat leaks from your home
  - o Insulation cracks near doors and windows
  - o More efficient doors and windows

#### 8. Tell me about housing assistance.

Sample answer:

- Services can include affordable housing development, rent assistance and other housing support
- Help fighting mortgage foreclosures
- Referrals to homeless shelters or services
- Legal services to help with landlord or lease problems

#### 9. What is Food Support?

Sample Answer:

- Food Support is a government program to help low-income people get food
  - Used to be called "Food Stamps"
  - o Now uses electronic payment card EBT card
- Some Community Action agencies have food shelves
  - o Or they can refer you to nearby food shelves

#### 10. What services do you have for elderly people?

- Help staying in your home
  - Home chore services
- Assistance accessing health and other medical support services
- Food services
  - o Congregate dining (group dining)
  - Meals delivered to homes

#### 11. Tell me about financial fitness training

#### Sample Answer:

- Financial Fitness Training involves developing or improving the following skills:
  - Learning to budget and use money wisely
  - Avoiding debt and saving money
  - o Building good credit or repairing bad credit
  - o Understanding banks and credit unions
  - o Avoiding predatory lending and financial scams
    - Stay away from check-cashing places
  - o Tips for stretching a budget

#### 12. Tell me about free services for low-income people to help prepare and file taxes

#### Sample Answer:

- Community action agencies often partner with other agencies to offer this free service
- Filing state and federal income taxes
- Accessing credits such as
  - o Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) for low-wage workers
  - o Minnesota Working Families Credit
  - o Renters Credit
  - And more
- Avoiding predatory products such as refund anticipation loans (RALs)
- Watch out for people even those in your community who want to charge a high price to help you do taxes
- Paying taxes is like paying dues

#### 13. How can you help people who are looking for a job?

- Many of our agencies offer employment and training services
  - Help to get and keep a job
    - New job-related skills
    - Job support
      - resume building
      - transportation
      - child care
  - o We can also help you look for a better job

#### 14. Who can get services at Community Action Agencies?

#### Sample Answer:

- People with low incomes
  - o Different services have different guidelines of eligibility
- No geographical limits. Go to whatever agency is convenient for you.

#### 15. Does immigration status affect ability to get services?

#### Sample Answer:

- Everyone should come to community action to ask for help
- Some services are available and some services are not available to undocumented immigrants
- Undocumented workers will not be turned away or turned in to authorities
- Community Action Agencies are not reporting agencies
